While the collection of photos began in 2014, contributions from many observers date back to 2001. Photos were collected by Ocean Wise under MML-18, using a telephoto lens and cropped to size, unless otherwise stated in the photograph credits.

These data were collected on the traditional territory of the Ts’ymsen and Sm’algyax speaking peoples, who have been stewards of these lands and waters since time immemorial.

ABOUT HUMPBACK WHALES

Humpback whales (*Megaptera novaeangliae*) are large baleen whales found throughout every ocean in the world. Adults reach an average length of about 12 metres (40 feet) and can weigh up to 40,000 kilograms.

In the North Pacific, humpback whales have made an impressive recovery over the past 50 years. Commercial whaling heavily targeted this population until 1967, reducing their numbers to an estimated low of just 1,400 individuals. After whaling ended, the population steadily rebounded, reaching a peak of 35,549 whales in 2013. Between 2014 and 2016, a marine heatwave in the Pacific likely caused a population decline of approximately 20% (around 7,000 whales). Since then, abundance is estimated to be increasing again at a rate of about 4% per year (Cheeseman et al., 2023, 2024).

North Pacific humpback whales undertake some of the longest migrations of any mammal. Each year, they travel from winter breeding grounds in southern regions, such as Hawaii, Mexico, and parts of southern Asia, to northern feeding areas stretching from California to Alaska and Russia, where they spend the summer months. In summer, humpbacks forage in productive waters rich in prey, including krill and small schooling fish such as herring, capelin, sand lance, and pilchard.

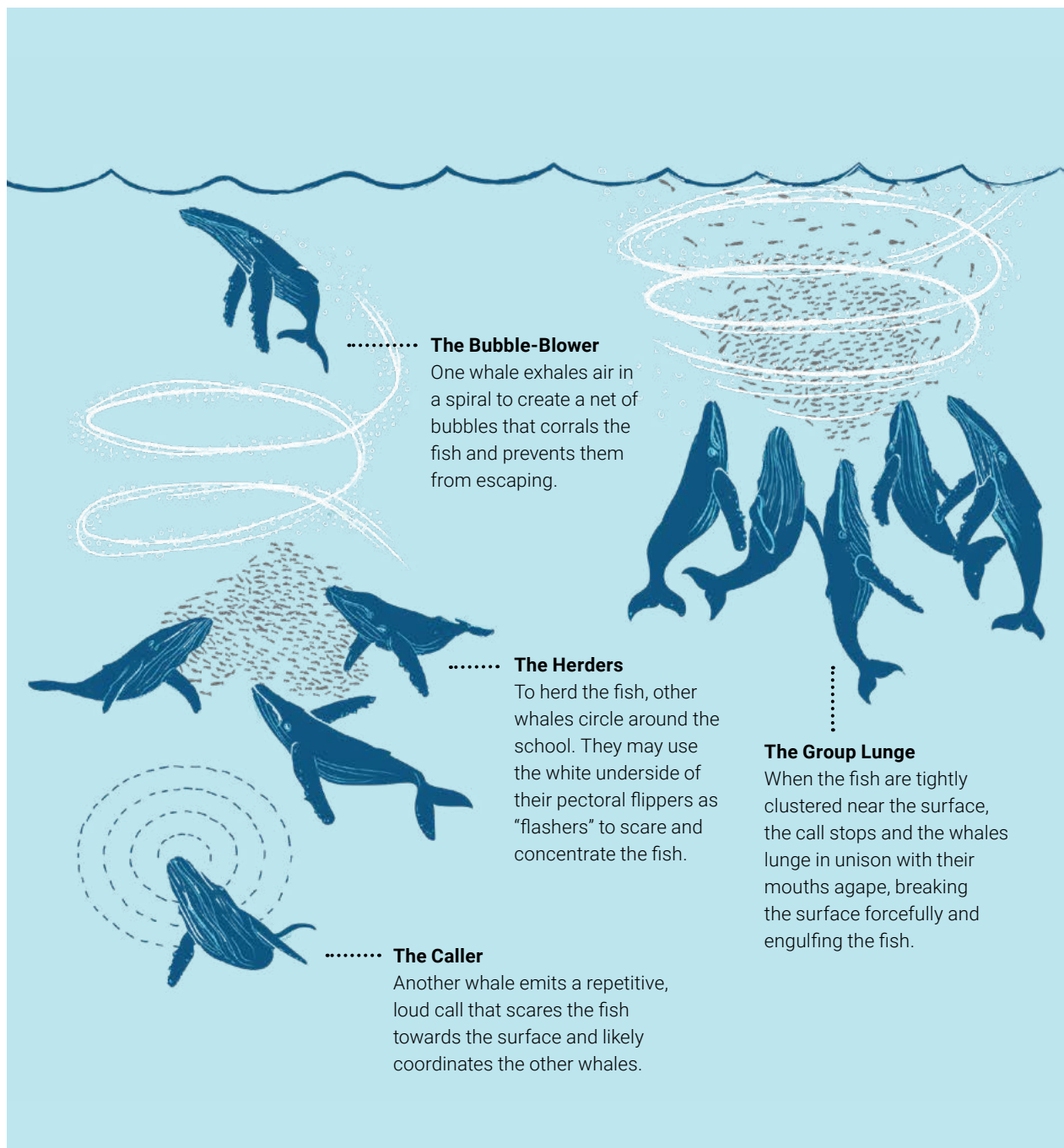
Among baleen whales, humpbacks are especially known for their energetic surface behaviours, including breaching and slapping the water with their tail flukes and long pectoral fins. While scientists have not identified a single explanation for these displays, they are thought to serve different purposes depending on the context.

Throughout much of their range, humpback whales are affected by human activities. Entanglement in fishing gear, vessel strikes, underwater noise, and overfishing all pose ongoing threats. In British Columbia, humpback whales are currently listed as “Special Concern” under the Species at Risk Act.

BUBBLE-NET FEEDING

Humpback whales are part of the family Balaenopteridae, also known as rorquals, which are distinguished by the long grooves that run from their lower jaw to their abdomen. These pleats allow their throats to expand, enabling them to engulf large volumes of prey-filled water in a single gulp. They then push the water through their baleen, rows of comb-like keratin plates that hang from the upper jaw, which filter out seawater while trapping prey inside their mouth.

Humpbacks use a variety of feeding strategies to capture prey. One of the most remarkable is bubble-net feeding, in which one or several whales create a circular wall of bubbles to corral prey into a tight cluster before lunging upward through the centre with their mouths open.

HUMPBACKS OF THE NORTH COAST

This catalogue includes whales primarily observed in Chatham Sound, Work Channel, and Dixon Entrance East. Based on data collected from our citizen science project, the Ocean Wise Sightings Network (formerly B.C. Cetacean Sightings Network, wildwhales.org), humpback whales are the most commonly reported cetacean in this region. They are observed year-round in both winter and summer months; however, it remains unknown whether individuals remain in the area all year without migrating. As of January 2026, this catalogue includes 507 whales documented in this study area.

WHALE SAFETY

For the safety of both boaters and whales, vessels must operate with caution in areas where humpbacks may be present. In British Columbia, collisions with humpback whales have resulted in serious injuries to boaters and whales. Extra care should always be taken in areas of known or potential whale activity.

Humpback whales can surface suddenly and without warning, and may not be aware of nearby vessels. Boaters should never assume a whale knows where their boat is. At times, humpbacks may rest at the surface, a behaviour known as logging, which can make them difficult to spot. Boaters should be on alert to whale presence when transiting through coastal waters.

- Blows (exhalations)
- Splashes
- Ecotourism vessels stopped or slowed





SLOW DOWN

If whale presence is detected or if you are operating in an area that is often used by humpbacks, slow down. Boaters in Chatham Sound should particularly pay attention around the mouth of Work Channel and through Edye Pass in the summer, and the entrance to the Prince Rupert harbour and through Brown Pass in the winter. Both areas have a high degree of seasonal overlap between boats and whales.

DO NOT STOP IN THEIR TRAVEL PATH

Never stop in the travel path of a whale. If humpbacks are bubble-net feeding, give them additional space as their surfacing can be abrupt and powerful. Whales may be very focused on feeding and oblivious to vessels in their vicinity.

GIVE WHALES SPACE

The federal Marine Mammal Regulations require that vessels keep a minimum of 100 metres away from most whales, dolphins, and porpoises. For humpbacks that are resting or with their calf, the legal minimum distance is 200 metres. Consider the whale's behaviour and if there is a calf present when assessing your movement. Regulations vary by species and location along the BC coast, so ensure you are familiar with the specific requirements for the area you are navigating.

PLEASE REPORT

Report any incidents of disturbance, collision, or entanglement in fishing gear immediately to DFO's reporting line at **1-800-465-4336** or **Coast Guard VHF 16**. Never attempt to remove gear from a whale that is entangled on your own. Specialized teams for disentanglement are dispatched once reports are made.

This centralized database aids in understanding whale behaviour, habitat use, population size, and the impact of threats such as vessel strikes and entanglement. This work contributes to population level assessments, such as those by the Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC). In this way, Mer carries her story forward across the ocean she loved so deeply.
